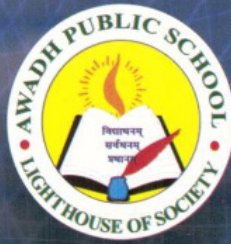


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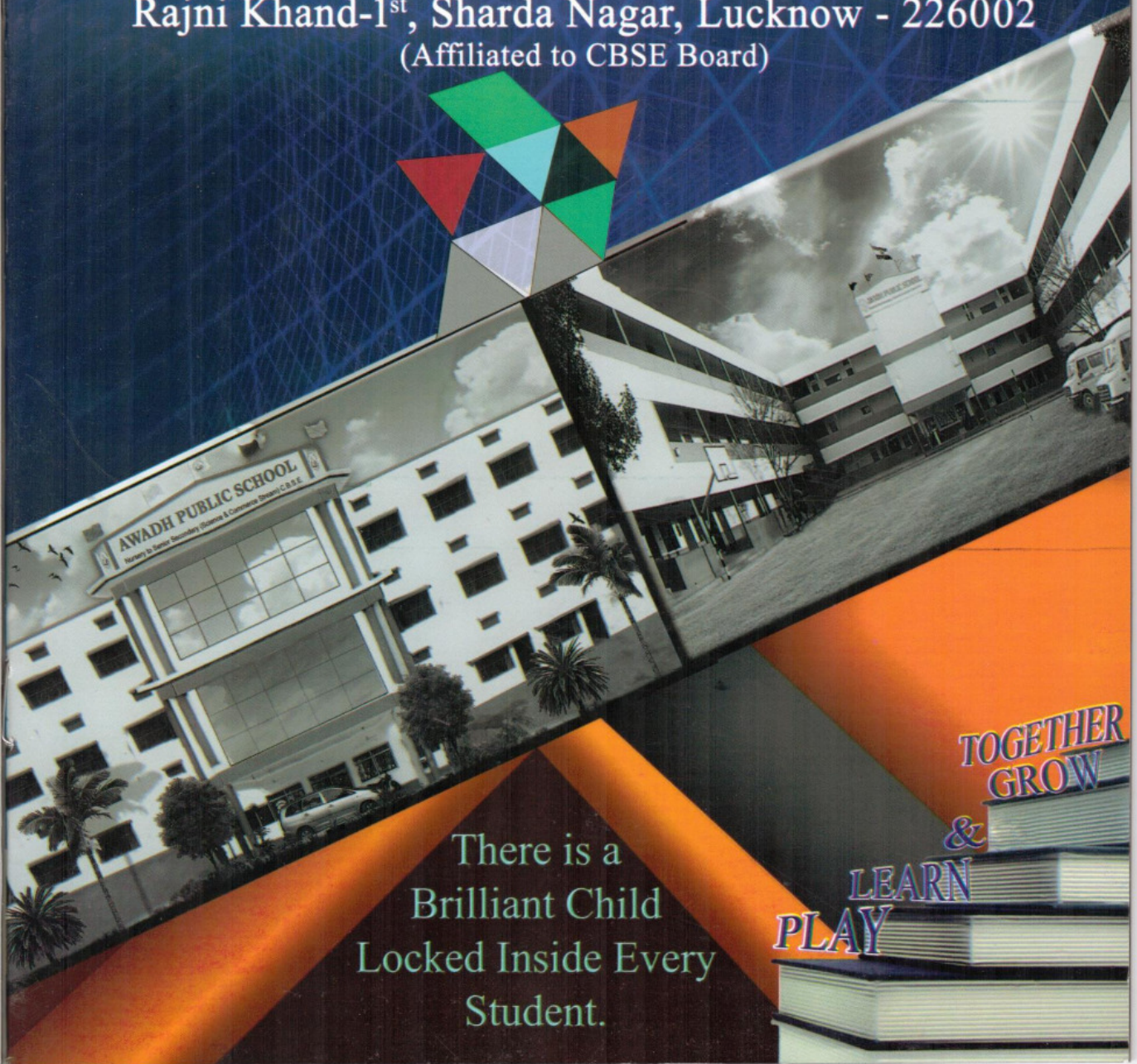

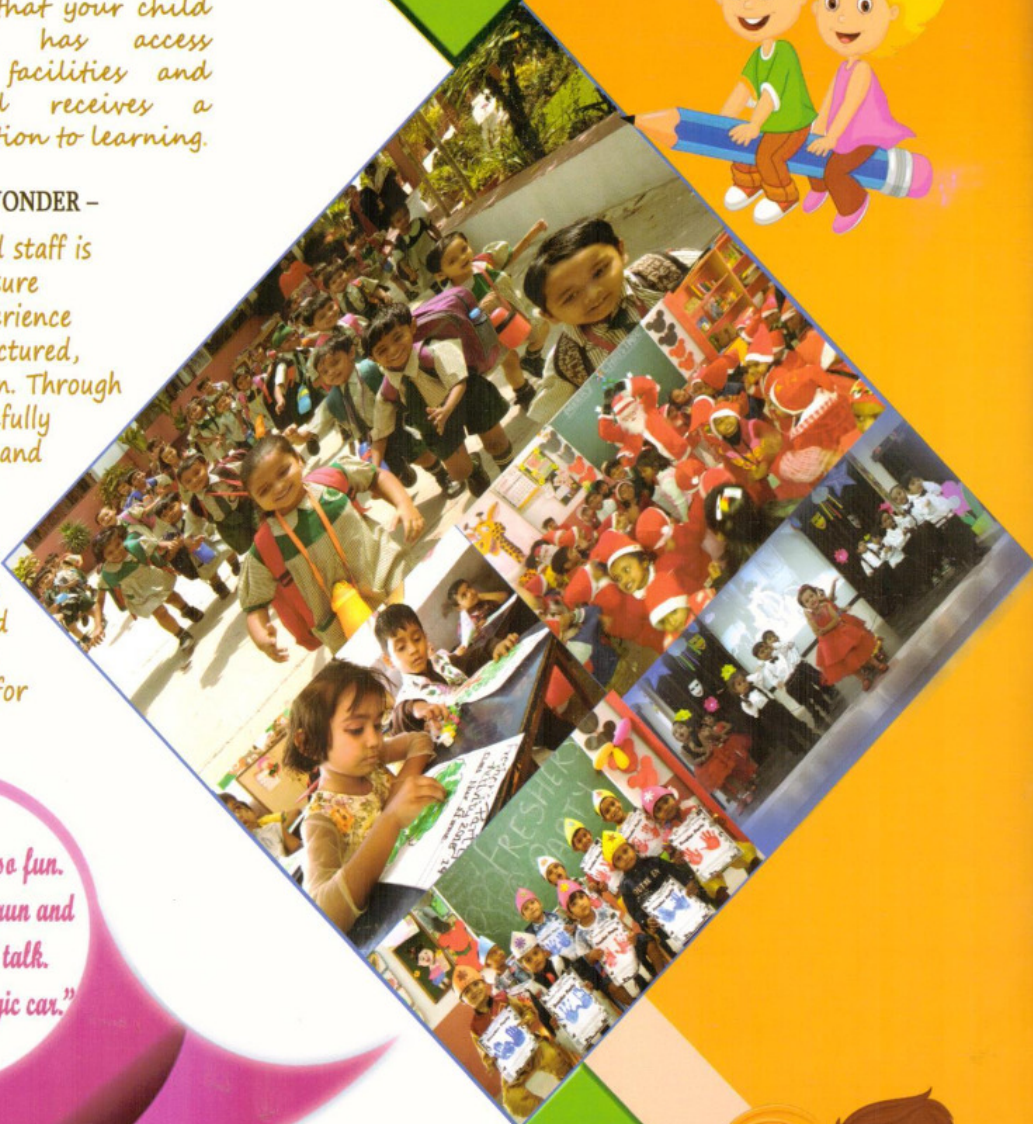

House system

Awadh Public School welcomes every student in a 'House' once they get enrolled, the school is divided into four houses namely Ashoka, Buddha, Chanakya and Eklavya to provide every student with in order to develop confidence & creativity and to make the child extrovert.

Assessments and Evaluation

In keeping with the recommendation of National Policy of Education and National Curriculum frame-work 2005, the School has integrated 'Evaluation' with the over all teaching-learning process in the form of Uniform system of assessment in both scholastic and co-scholastic areas in a scientific and objective manner. The child's progress in scholastic and non-scholastic area is reported to parents/guardians periodically as under:-

Classes I-VIII:

The school shall implement uniform system of assessment, examination pattern for classes I-VIII. The assessment structure of the examination for these classes will comprise of two terms i.e. Term 1 and Term 2.

Term 1 is the first half of the session which will be of 100 marks comprising 20 marks for periodic assessment and 80 marks for half yearly exam. Periodic Assessment will include 10 marks for Periodic Test ,5 marks for Notebook Submission and Written Work for the term at the end of it and remaining 5 marks for the Subject Enrichment Activities.

Term 2 is the second half of the session which will be of 100 marks comprising 20 marks for periodic assessment and 80 marks for yearly exam. Periodic assessment will be same as in Term 1.

However, in annual examination of classes VI-VIII, significant topics of 1st term in each subject will be included along with second term syllabus. The annual progress report is given after the compilation of Term 1 and Term 2 results.

Classes IX-XII: Evaluation of students is done as per CBSE guidelines and directives.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. The School admits the children (boys/girls) from the age of 2 ½ years in the playgroup purely on the basis of interaction.
2. Admission upto Class II is based on child's performance in the interview. Whereas, for class III-IX and XI admission would be done through both entrance test as well as interview.
3. Guardians of the candidates selected for admission are required to present a photocopy of the report card of the previous class and transfer certificate from the school last attended at the time of admission.
4. Those coming from other districts should have their T.C. counter signed by a competent educational authority of place. Birth certificate in original from Nagar Mahapalika/Maternity Hospital would be required for the admission in playgroup & pre-primary classes.
5. Guardian/Parents are requested to fill the form correctly and adhere to the instructions mentioned there in. The name of the student, date of birth, father's name, mother's name will not be changed once filled in the form.

ACADEMIC SESSION

Our's is a summer bound school. The academic session commences in April and ends in March.

There are two terms:-

1st Term

April to September

2nd Term

October to March

SCHOOL DIARY

School Diary makes you aware about the rules and guidelines of the school. It creates a link between the school and parents. Parents are requested to sign the diary of their ward regularly to get updated about remarks & information concerning the child.

ATTENDANCE

1. 80% attendance is compulsory to appear in the terminal examination.
2. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward attend the school regularly.
3. 'Leave record' page in the diary should be used for citing the reason of absence for one or two days only. For more than two day leave an application addressed to the Principal should be sent along with the requisite documents (Medical Certificate/Fitness Certificate).
4. Students will not be permitted to take leave during the periodic tests, terminal examinations and functions/events.

LATE ARRIVAL

1. Parents should ensure that their ward reach the school on time .
2. If the child comes late more than three times in a month, he/she will be sent back home, and also a penalty of Rs.5 shall be charged.

WITHDRAWAL & TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

1. Information of withdrawal must be given in writing at least one month in advance.
2. Transfer certificate will be issued after clearing all dues with in 15 working days from the date of form submission.

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Students should reach school 5 minutes before the first bell. They should be present in the class at the start of the period and in time for all other activities and functions. If a student arrives late without permission more than thrice he/she will not be allowed to attend school on that day.
2. Attendance on the last day of the school before vacation and first day of the school after vacation is absolutely essential. However, absence on the first day will be permitted for special reasons with the prior permission of the Principal. When student is absent without prior permission, he/she will be liable for disciplinary action.
3. Leave application should be sent in advance or with the student when he/she joins school after leave. Record of leave of absence must be maintained in the school diary.
4. School Diary should be brought to school everyday.
5. Any student found shabbily dressed may be asked to go back home. Guardians are requested to send their ward to school in prescribed neat and well-ironed uniform.
6. Students are strictly prohibited from wearing expensive accessories to school.
7. Exchange of articles or money transactions among students is not permitted.
8. Running, shouting or screaming inside the school building is not allowed.
9. Indisciplined behavior in the school transport will result in the student being debarred from using the transport.
10. A student who uses unfair means in the examination will render himself/herself liable to such disciplinary action as is considered necessary by the Principal.
11. Care must be taken of school property and no student should scratch or damage school property or write on the walls or cause damage in any way to any item belonging to the school or to others in the school. **ANY DAMAGE DONE WILL RENDER THE STUDENT LIABLE FOR RECOVERY OF DAMAGES.**
12. Every student should take care of his/her personal belonging. School authorities will not be responsible for loss of such belongings.
13. Students of all classes should prepare school bags as per the Time Table to avoid carrying heavy bags.
14. Students are forbidden to bring cell phones, CDs, DVDs, Pen drives, I-Pods, MP3s to the school. If any student is found in possession of one, the same will be confiscated and donated to charity.
15. Use of foul, abusive or any unparliamentarily language within and outside the school premises is not permitted.
16. Any behavior likely to cause hurt to others like bullying or in the matter of language, religion, caste or community is strictly prohibited.
17. All the students are expected to keep up the values taught in school by excelling in conduct, good manners and cleanliness inside and outside the school.

VIOLATION OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL AND THE CODE OF CONDUCT WILL RENDER THE CONCERNED STUDENT LIABLE TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

We, at Awadh public school believe in the development of values and ethics. Therefore, the school strives to inculcate a sense of responsibility and moral conduct in its students.

School Transport Guidelines

The provision of school transport is not a matter of right but a facility provided to students. Transport facility for new admissions or students who have changed their address is subject to its availability.

1. The school has put into place an efficient transport system which may be availed of by interested parents for their wards wishing to commute from their residence to school and back.
2. The school has earmarked area/zone routes on which our vehicles ply. These routes are fixed and we can't deviate from them due to logistic reasons.
3. A transportation fee is levied keeping in mind fixed and operational costs.
4. Our drivers have been ordered to stop vehicle **ONLY** at the designated point.
5. The vehicles will **NOT WAIT** for **LATE COMERS**. Students must reach the boarding point three minutes prior to the scheduled arrival time. (This time is intimated at the time of registering)
6. In the interest of the security of your ward, you are requested to kindly have your child escorted by a responsible adult to and from the bus stop to residence.
7. School transport facility will be withdrawn if:
 - There is persistent complaint for unruly behavior/willful damage/vandalism/late coming.
 - There are repeated complaints of throwing trash/food/objects at fellow commuters out of the windows.
 - Indulging in acts that compromise the safety of fellow commuters.
 - Non-payment of the transportation fee
8. One month written notice should be given for discontinuance of transport facility in our school office.

The above has been drafted keeping the safety of students in mind and ensuring a comfortable, safe and punctual travel.

Mode of Fee Payment

1. Fees must be paid positively between 1 & 10 of every month either in cash or by cheque & card alongwith fee card.
2. Failing this, the same shall be accepted with a late fee of Rs. 30/- between 11 & 20 of every month either in cash or by cheque & card alongwith fee card.
3. If you fail to deposit the fees by 20th of the month then fees shall be accepted with a late fee of Rs. 100/- between 21 & 30/31 of every month either in cash or by cheque & card alongwith with fee card.
4. If you fail to deposit the fee of your ward in any month the name of your ward will automatically be struck off the roll without any notice or information.
5. To re-admit the child you will have to pay Rs. 200/- as re-admission charges with all dues.
6. A bounced/dishonored cheque will attract a penalty of Rs. 350/- and fee will be deposit in cash or by card only, there after.
7. A fine of Rs. 20 per day will be charged along with Rs. 200/- readmission charges, if the fee remains unpaid for more than one month.
8. Those who wish to come by cycle must pay the Rs. 720/- per year. at the beginning of the session.

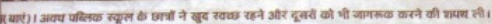
